## ***Pacification of the Church***

As the church races towards the last days, social breakdown will occur. This is because worldly and selfish influences will infiltrate the church. It happens through the lives of well intentioned Christians who do not realize they are being used by the Devil. He must break down the unity of the church in order to bring into effect his grand deception--to use the church (the body of Christ) against the Saviour. For years now, the Devil has been isolating Christians so that he can deplete the ranks of believers, while at the same time cause them to be pacified to his working within them. The job of infiltrating the church is not as simple as putting on a sheep's skin and milling about the flock. He knows it must first come with a pacification.

A bee keeper will blow smoke over the hive in order to pacify it. Then, when they are properly placated, he can have his way with it; he can tear it apart and remove all of the honey. In a similar way, the Devil has been working on the church for decades, blowing smoke. It is with similar thoughts that God tells us in Philippians 2:3 to, *"Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each*

*esteem other better than themselves."* If the isolated members of the church do not want themselves to be devoured by the Devil's deception, they will not think so highly of themselves. They will seek out the betterment of others, instead of high minded looking down on others. And make no mistake, this has been a problem in the church since the beginning of it's conception. When Jesus told Peter he would organize the church using him to do it, Peter resisted the Lord and Jesus told him, "Get thee behind me Satan." (Matt. 16:18-23). Peter resisted God's plan because he thought that he knew better than the Father. He made himself equal to God (Phil. 2:5-6) when he should not have.

Practically speaking, the Devil has been working on members of the church to make them consider themselves as deserving. He convinces them that they deserve fame, reputation, attention, important and worthy to express their opinion. This causes a breakdown in the church and creates factions. He is very intelligent and knows that they easiest way to conquer is to first divide. On a basic level, he makes people

*Mt. 7:24-25 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.*

These are exciting times here in Scotland as the country prepares to vote for their Independence to break away from the United Kingdom on the 18<sup>th</sup> of September. The hype is high, being the first chance at Independence in 700 years, and there are street campaigners pushing for a yes vote every weekend. If Independence goes through, there could be major changes to our immigration status, hopefully for the better! We are currently under the British U.K. system and even our sponsor lives in England, so please pray that it all works out for the better.

It has been a busy summer and now four of our five boys are being homeschooled by my wife Angie. She is an excellent teacher and their first week of the year was a success, but please pray for both of us as this is sometimes a two person job!

My friend Owen's mother passed away recently, and I was given the opportunity to give the gospel to her in her last hours. I had met her before as I went to witness to her about two years ago when she was in an assisted living facility. This time she was unable to communicate but we believe she was able to hear. Some of the family was there at the bedside as well and greatly appreciated the visit. They also asked me to preach the funeral service which went very well. It was a very good opportunity to preach to about forty people, mostly unsaved. I led the congregation in a salvation prayer at the end of the service, but did not feel led to ask for a show of hands from those who received Christ. Based on the positive response of some afterward, however, my hope is that some people truly gave their hearts to Jesus that day! Sometimes only eternity will tell.

As many of you know, we have been filling in for another missionary to keep his church going while he has been on furlough for the last 14 months. Brother Weaver and his family plan to get back here on the 10<sup>th</sup> of September and we will be starting up again a half an hour north in Dunfermline, where we live, on Sunday mornings. We prayed many times for our town centre meeting place to open up on Sunday mornings but it never did during that first year on the mission field and we could only get it on Saturdays. I inquired again recently and the door is now open to start on Sunday mornings! I have been told that I am the 4<sup>th</sup> missionary to try to start a church in Dunfermline in recent years, and one problem has always been getting a place on Sunday morning. We also have had time to make more contacts and there are more interested people now than we had the first year. We are excited about what the Lord wants to do. Please pray that He has His way! I have also been trying to extend the public school ministry up to this area as well. The people who can get me in have shown interest but have been very slow in responding to emails. Pray it all works out as it is an exceptional opportunity to reach those with the most potential of all, youngsters.

A young man by the name of Garaith (pronounced 'Gary' in American English) received one of my tracts and contacted me last month. It turns out he is a zealous KJV Bible Believer who got saved about a year ago and is mostly self taught through online resources. I have been working with him a lot lately and doing some Bible studies with him. He loves to hold big banners while I preach on the streets and he is striving to be a good witness, always asking when we can go again! It is really a blessing to have someone like him around, who sees the great need in his country and wants to do something about it.

## Robert and Sherah Trump Missionaries to Germany

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

August 2014

We are rejoicing in the Lord for all that has happened during the month of August. Thank you for joining with us in prayer, as some of our prayers were answered this month. On top of that, Chick Publications donated a couple thousand tracts to the ministry.

**The nursing home ministry has officially begun.** Before I could have entered the facility to meet and interact with the people, a social worker had to find a resident that she thought would benefit from me coming in. After deciding that a bedridden woman could use some cheering up, she cleared it with the woman's family and I was allowed to start coming in. I've since met with this woman four times and have also met her family.

Again, this is the beginning. I am now allowed to talk to and befriend other people in the home while I make my usual visits to meet with this woman. I've met some other folks already and I am confident that soon I will be meeting with several of them on a regular basis. **Please pray that this ministry would grow and that one day I could have scheduled group meetings or services on Sundays, amongst other days. Pray also for the women I am currently visiting.** (I've agreed not to disclose their personal information.)

During the month of August, Sherah and I started hitting the streets with a new kind of public ministry. We've been taking a video camera and a microphone out with us into the city center. Up until recently, getting people to stop and talk while we were tract passing had been unsuccessful, but with a camerawoman (Sherah) and a microphone in my hand, it works great. We now get conversations going 15-30 minutes.

I've started by asking some questions about the religious vocabulary here in Germany. I wasn't surprised to find that some Bible words are just about extinct, and others are used very differently today. I then swing into the discussion about God and whether the people think they are "good" people or not. I then take them through the Ten Commandments.

I'm planning on taking this idea throughout the Stuttgart metro area and beyond. Thank you for your prayer support, as I'm learning how to better handle leading people down the road to salvation amongst the German roadblocks. During the interviews, I've only been able to give the full gospel to two people up to this point, because the other interviewees either couldn't make it past a couple of commandments without clinging to their "innocence" or frankly expressed that they were going to Hell and weren't concerned about it. **Please pray therefore for the conviction of the German people.**

There is "Youth Café" about 4 minutes down our street that I'd also like to get into. The café's purpose is to provide another (or better) place for teenagers to go during the hours of 6PM - 11PM, on Friday nights (a sensible idea). There's a snack bar, all sorts of games, and couches for the teens to make use of, and the management of the place desires volunteer adults to oversee its operation on Friday nights. There's seems to be a position open right now and I've contacted the administration regarding it, but nothing has been decided yet. **Please pray that I will fill this position and regularly be able to be a witness to these kids.**

I will leave you with these thoughts and prayers Brethren. We are very grateful for your prayers and financial support. **Pray that we would experience new successes and opportunities in the ministry.**

feel deserving to accomplish that. These victims can be identified by their willingness to talk about self, injustices, complaints, or any other subject than Jesus. Such people are divided from the rest of the flock, vulnerable and precarious. Their actions call out for help as they experience the conflict of being saved while at the same time serving self or the Devil. Like dealing with a drowning man, great caution should be taken when being within their proximity.

When a person is drowning, the way you save their life is to wait for them to get so tired that they have no more strength in them. If you help them when they are strong, panicked and struggling, they will pull you under, or in this case, separate you from the flock as well. So you observe and wait nearby for them to stop being prideful, bitter, haughty, vindictive, complaint riddled and mean spirited. When they are this way, they are struggling against God, separated from the others by the Devil. Until they are willing to stop struggling, you can do nothing to help them. The only thing you can do is to keep your distance, call out to them to calm themselves, and pray for them.

Christians want Jesus to be the center of attention. This is why they enjoy talking about Him, His personality and Character. True Christians do not want to wait for the day that every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord (Phil. 2:10-11). They already do it now. They enjoy humbling themselves to elevate the love of their life--Lord Jesus Christ. Something inside them makes them cringe when they start to talk about themselves, their accomplishments and achievements. Something inside them catches their attention when they begin complaining about other things or people. Something inside them has no problem apologizing to others. Something inside them wants to humble themselves even if others don't do so to them. Something inside them strives for unity of the spirit (Eph. 4:3) and inspires them to sentinel warriors when anyone complains about their Lord, their church, their brethren, their deacons or pastor. These mentioned things that describe true Christians are explained in the Bible as, "With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace." (Eph. 4:2-3).~

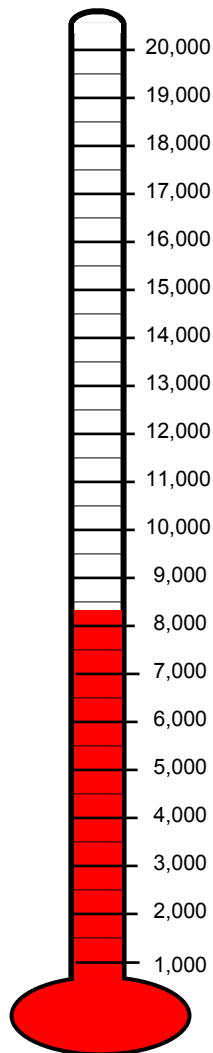
