Hello once again from hot and humid Cambodia! Thank you so much for holding us up in prayer to God. We are very excited to report the many blessings that God has bestowed upon our many different ministries. We would like to remind you that we will be taking our furlough at the end of the year. If you would like for us to come visit your church, please contact us via email.

Ra and Sopheap made a profession of faith in early February and they have been faithfully attending our Prek Bang church ever since. They live in Vihear Suor village which is about five kilometers away from Prek Bang village. There are several other families in Vihear Suor that are open to the Gospel. Please pray for Ra and Sopheap's four children to get saved.

Srey Lin also attends our church in Prek Bang and she received Christ several weeks ago. She comes to church every week with her baby. Her mother, Kim Hua, has attended church a couple of times, but is not yet saved. She told us that she believes seventy percent of the Gospel. Please pray that Kim Hua will accept Christ soon and that Srey Lin will continue to grow in the Lord.

Srey Nith accepted Christ as her Saviour in January, and she has been very faithful in attending our church in Prek Bang since trusting Christ. We have witnessed to her grandmother a couple of times and she has listened very carefully. She is very close to getting saved. Please pray that Srey Nith's grandma will receive Christ soon and that Srey Neat will continue to be a good testimony at home.

Grandma Yen accepted Christ a couple of months ago, and ever since then, she has been persecuted by her neighbors and family members. They have prevented her from coming to church. Her daughter, Srey Mean, just had surgery on her eye and is also saved. Please pray that Grandma Yen and Srey Mean won't be discouraged and that their relatives will allow her to come to church.

For the last couple of months a group of our Cham believers have ventured into new villages to witness and pass out tracts. One of the villages they have been going to is the Chom Ka village. In just a short time, they have seen several adults make a profession of faith. A couple of weeks ago, San, one of our good men, invited fifteen people from this village to our mid-week service, and praise the Lord, they came! Please pray for these new believers as they are experiencing persecution already.

In February we had a Celebration service where all of our churches come together and worship. We saw eight people get baptized that day.

The bible gives us a very practical formula for "adjusting our attitude." It tells us how to both maintain a good attitude as well as how to change our attitude if it slips. I guess that God knows we are all going to need some help in this area so He tells us how to control this all important state of mind. He tells us in some verses of Scripture that I like to call the "Whatsoever verses." They can be found in Philippi-

○ Whatsoever things are true,

○ Whatsoever things are honest,

○ Whatsoever things are just,

○ Whatsoever things are pure,

○ Whatsoever things are lovely,

○ Whatsoever things are of good report;

○ If there be any virtue, and

○ If there be any praise, ***think on these things.***

If you spend some time thinking on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, good report, virtue and praise, then you will keep a good attitude. You

can never get a "look on your face" that needs to be wiped off.

The world does not think on these things very much anymore. When I was growing up they did. Today it seems as if the exact opposite is what people think on and this is why such poor attitudes are predominate. People think on lies, deceit, cheating, adulterated, hate, misdirection, envy and self. Because the world has rejected God's formula for attitude adjustment, they are hopelessly unable to change.

Do you have anything in your life that is true? Is there not truth anywhere? The Bible clearly tells us that Jesus is truth (John 14:6). Even if you are not a Christian, Jesus is still in your life. He may not take up residence on the throne of your heart,
