# The Last Days

In the olden days there was much more respect for our fellow citizen than there is today. I believe this is a phenomena that is a by product of selfish living. Oh, I don't mean selfish

in the sense that a person cares that someone else got something that they didn't get. Yes! That is a problem too, but I'm talking about selfishness in the sense that there is too much emphasis on pleasing one's self and not enough emphasis on caring for others.

When the Jews sought to Kill Jesus for healing the impotent man on the Sabbath, He answered the angry crowd of Jews with many words justifying His action (John 5:14-47). One of the most intriguing things that He said in that discourse was, "I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but

the will of the Father which hath sent me." (John 5:30) This is the selfishness of where I speak. It is the selfishness that seeks it's own will and ignores the will of others. Jesus was always seeking to do what His Father wanted. He always strived to please His Father. Not for reward or praise, but because of love.

In the late 50's and early 60's, people related to each other in a different way than they do today. This was the time just before drive through hamburger joints. Yes, there were drive-up restaurants, but not drive through restaurants. It was the time of milk, eggs, butter, bread and cases of coco-cola being delivered right to your door step. I was visiting a supporting church recently and the pastor spoke up about how my hair seemed to be thinning and turning gray in comparison to the last time I visited. I guess I could join the Apostle Paul in saying "this witness is true!" We aren't getting any younger but we have been given the opportunity to serve Him understanding that only what's done for Christ will last. While we have breath we will strive to redeem the time and do something to help the next generation. "Even so, come, Lord Jesus."

We passed a good portion of September in Florida helping our children get started with schooling. During some of this time I was with Andrew and Priscilla in Pensacola while Esther was with Jonathan and Abigail in Vero Beach. In Pensacola, I was able to lead a 53 year old man named David to the Lord as well as get a good witness in to an old "retired" biker named Gary who, although boasting of a tough and sinful life, listened to some very straight forward preaching in which I gave him salvation plain and simple. Also pray for a young man named Jason who had a decent profession of salvation but has ruined his life in some ways and needs to come to the Lord and get things right. We had some meetings in Florida, Tennessee and Georgia before heading out west for some additional meetings in California, Arizona, New Mexico, Nevada and Idaho. I can't say enough about the fine treatment we have received from the churches we've visited. Although we have been able to do quite a bit in Mozambique, in several ways we feel like we are just getting started and are humbled by the reception and interest shown for our labors.

Fazenda and Agostinho have both given me good reports from the churches in Mozambique so at least I'm not aware of any issues at the moment! The only real news seems to be continued political strife

Today we seldom see acts of selflessness as there once was. Today, it is not the selfless society; It is now the selfish society, or rather could I call it the "ME GENERATION." It is nothing to be surprised about because the Bible tells us it will come. 2 Timothy 3:1-5..... 1This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. 2For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, 4Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; 5Having a form of godli-

ness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. It sounds like an exact description of the "ME GENERATION".

Today's generation is disrespectful, and rarely do you find instances of thinking of others in the fashion of the "selfless society." Unfortunately there is very little we can do to help them until they are humbled at their inability to be the revolutionary they once thought they were.

There is little we can do until their folly is manifest to all men as well as themselves (2 Tim. 3:9). Until then, Paul advises that we:

1. Stay away from them.
2. Continue in the things that we have learned in the Bible (2 Tim. 3:14)
3. Preach Sound Doctrine. (2 Tim. 4:2)

which has resulted in a few road attacks and some civilian deaths near Chimoio. I don't expect any of this to escalate but it would be nice to see them resolve their issues. As I have mentioned, one of our plans for our return is to get a Bible institute going. Our Regra study is good but I believe an institute will give more needed help in the word as well as in church administration. I have been able to record 30 lessons of about 50 minutes each for the Life of Christ course and still have a bit more to go to finish everything which I hope to do shortly. I also talked with Elias. He still has a final visit set up with his doctor in South Africa this coming January, but he is improving, praise the Lord!

Our time has passed quickly here in the states and we are making some progress. We still have some things to do before our return but are looking forward to getting back to Mozambique. Thank you for all your prayers and support.

4. Watch all things (2 Tim. 4:5)
5. Endure afflictions (2 Tim. 4:5)
6. Win as many souls as we can (2 Tim. 4:5)
