Pastor and praying friends,

We have been staying busy as of late, doing what we can to be a blessing at church, and continuing my language studies. I have finished my first semester of Language school, and I am planning on signing up for a second. The second semester starts at the beginning of September, and I am a little nervous about it. I am enjoying handing out tracts, but am itching to open my mouth and say something, so please pray for my language learning! I can witness a little in Lithuanian, but I will most likely not be able to answer any questions they would have, so I still have a ways to go. I have been giving myself writing assignments in the mean time, to help keep what I have learned fresh in my mind. I also try not to stay attached at the hip to my wife when we are in town, that way I talk to people at stores myself, and not rely on her to translate for me. I would say about most of the Lithuanians in customer service speak English (and they recognize that I am American), but they don't speak to me in English when they see that I am trying to talk to them in Lithuanian. A couple have told me that I can speak to them in English, but I replied "Thank you, but that wont help me learn".

My mother-in-law came for a visit, and we are trying to get her to come back and stay with us for about a week. She went to church and enjoyed it, as the pastor actually expounded on the word of God, not just skimmed over it like the Catholic priests do! She was also excited because he gave her a bible, and encouraged her to read it. She is coming this weekend to hear me preach (pastor Tomas is taking some much needed time off, so he asked me to preach for him Sunday), so please pray the word of God has free course throughout the service. We are praying for her salvation, so please keep her in your prayers!

My back doesn't hurt anymore (praise the Lord!!), but Vaida's is giving her problems now. She had a doctors appointment a couple of days ago, and found out that one of her discs is bulging a little bit. The doctor gave her some exercises and stretches to do, so please keep her in your prayers!

I was able to organize a men's retreat about a month ago. It was good! The Lithuanians really enjoyed it (we have a few Americans in the church as well), so I'd call that a success! They want to make it a yearly event, so I hope to be in the area to help them next year, but after that, we plan on being in my wife's home town.
