The past few months I have been working on a short tract that I wrote in Greenlandic and Danish. I have had help with the translation using professional Greenlandic and Danish translators. This has opened up an opportunity to be a witness to them. How awesome it would be for one of them to be born again. This has also allowed me to learn more about the Greenlandic and Danish languages. Simple words and phrases that we use in English cannot always be translated easily to another language and still convey the same meaning. Because of this, I have had to delete what I thought were really simple sentences. It has made for a very concise tract. ☺ The basic process is to write in English, then translate it to Danish and then to Greenlandic. I will then back translate their work to see if I arrive at my original English thoughts. It is a lot of work for a simple tract. There is a lot that I still don't understand with the Greenlandic, but this allows me to ask questions and thus learn.

We continue to work with the Shull family in their church ministries participating where we can. Sometimes it is just simply cleaning up after the weekly kid's

club, playing the guitar for songs, or providing more adult supervision for the kids that come. Recently, I was helping a young boy (approx. 10 years old) with one of the Bible verse activities. I would ask him to repeat the word, but he would not respond. It made me question my pronunciation, but I kept trying. I finally realized that he could not read. He wasn't trying to ignore me, he just couldn't do it. After repeating the verse several times to him, he finally opened up and tried to repeat the verse the best he could. He was really close to memorizing the whole verse by the end of the night. The smile on his face was priceless. He is not the only child in that scenario. However, some of the children are really sharp. They can quickly memorize and repeat the Bible verses with no problem making their language seem so simple. Please continue to pray for these ministries.
